2015 Registration Statistics

We are happy to report 3,345 lives have been saved in South Carolina through organ transplantation since the launch of the SC First Person Consent Registry in 2008.

South Carolina Donor Designation Rate:

- On December 31, 2015 there were 1,612,347 registered donors in South Carolina
- ➤ In 2015, 40% of customers applying for a SCDMV Credential (SC Driver's License, ID or Permit) registered as an organ, eye and tissue donor
- 419 lives saved through organ donation
- 205 lives enhanced through tissue donation
- 370 individuals have received the gift of sight

It allows supporters of both schools to help their "team" win by signing up more organ, eye and tissue donors on the South Carolina Organ and Tissue Donor Registry.



South Carolina Governor's Joint Press Conference on National Donate Life Month held at State House

Donate Life South Carolina, LifePoint and the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles gathered in Columbia to kickoff the National Donate Life Celebrations throughout the month month of April.

The press conference announced the results of the first year of the renewed partnershp to increase the number of registerd donors in the state. Speakers included Governor Nikki Haley, SCDMV Executive Director Kevin A. Shwedo, heart recipient mom Jane Davis and donor dad Ed Billings. Senator Shealy announced a Senate resolution, designating the month of April as Donate Life Month in South Carolina.

LifePoint and DLSC Launch New "I AM AME" Donor Initiative






