

We began 2016 by celebrating 20 years of service in South Carolina. To all our partners, volunteers, and supporters we say, "Thank You!" for assisting us over the years. Without a dedicated community, we could not have touched the lives of so many.

In addition to the many established registry events completed throughout the year, we accomplished the release of several new public awareness campaigns. These include:

- the unveiling of our new Donate Life vehicle wraps.
- the promotion of Donate Life Day on April 15, 2016, at the RBC Heritage Golf Tournament through a charitable community partnership with the Heritage Classic Foundation.
- the launch of our newly redesigned Donate Life South Carolina website.
- establishing educational curriculum that meet current standards for the development of the "SC



Donation Adolescent Awareness" plan in partnership with the SC Dept. of Education and the SCDHEC. The pilot program focuses on all aspects of donation and will be introduced to students in grades 6-

12 in Sept. 2017.

In closing the year, we celebrated the success of our "Bells for Life, Donate Life South Carolina and South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles" campaign that we implemented in 2015. Working together, the South Carolina donor registration rate increased by 16%! The success of the campaign led to DLSC and the SCDMV receiving the Donate Life America Pinnacle Platinum Award presented at the annual Donate Life America convention in Las Vegas, Nevada on October 26, 2016.

#### DLA PINNACLE PLATINUM AWARD

Each Year Donate Life America identifies proven and successful donor registration initiatives in the DLA community and recognizes chosen winners through the Pinnacle Awards program. We are proud to announce that Donate Life South Carolina and the South Carolina



Department of Motor Vehicles was awarded the Platinum Pinnacle Award for 2016. Inspiration and teamwork proved to be a perfect combination in creating the partnership campaign "Bells for Life" between Donate Life South Carolina and the South Carolina DMV. The campaign idea was simple... place Donate Life branded blue and green desk bells in customer service stations throughout SCDMV offices. Each time someone says "YES" to signing up as a donor or contributes money they can ring the Donate Life Bell. Staff and other customers then applaud for their registry decision. The success of the initiative, implemented in June 2015, realized the highest percentage of donor registrants per capita and extended the donate LIFE message throughout the state.



### NEW WAYS TO "REGISTER TODAY"

The South Carolina Registry, implemented in 2008, began with a simple message: "REGISTER TODAY". In 2016, advancing technology offered new and innovative ways of giving South Carolinians quick and easy access to register as organ, eye





Apple and Donate Life America released a new addition to the iPhone Health app that allows iPhone users to 'Save Lives' with just the tap of a finger! The pre-installed Health app on the iPhone update iOS10, released in July, includes

an option for users to sign up as organ donors. The organ, eye and tissue donor app registrations are sent to the National Donate Life Registry managed by Donate Life America and transferred immediately to the South Carolina Donor Registry.

DLSC released another new tool for donor registration using SWIPE technology. The launch of the new app assists our outreach partners in registering more residents during public events by using








# SC State Registry

Five-Year Donor Designation Rate Information




### Comparing the past 5 years...

# KICK OFF AT THE CAPITAL CELEBRATING NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH

News crews were on hand at the State Capital on April 6, 2016, as Katrina Shealy SC Senate of Lexington County announced a Senate Resolution declaring April as Donate Life Month. South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles Acting Executive Director John Laganelli and Donate Life SC CEO Tracy Armstrong announced the results of the renewed partnership between the two organizations. Other speakers included: Lynn Finley (mother of donor Jesse Gamble) and Jessalyn Taylor (daughter of Henry Harris, Jesse's heart recipient). ### SCDMV TEAM SUCCESS



Donate Life South Carolina state team joined Donate Life America the week of September 19-23 in recognizing the important role the Motor Vehicle Departments serve throughout the country in their commitment to encouraging DMV customers to register as organ, eye and tissue donors. Donate Life South Carolina CEO Tracy Armstrong presented SC Department of Motor Vehicles Executive Director Colonel Kevin Shwedo with

a Certificate of Appreciation for his and the DMV's role in saving lives across South Carolina. Over 1 million #HEROS have registered at SC DMVs since the registry launched in December of 2008.

With 52 of 67 SCDMV offices participating, the partnership campaign has increased the designation rate by 16% and public monetary contributions by 62%. Donate Life South Carolina appreciates its partnership with the SCDMV and the substantial impact made in promoting the Donate LIFE message and saving lives across South Carolina.
