#### **2019 REGISTRATION STATISTICS**

We are happy to report that **51** lives were saved in South Carolina through living donation in 2019.



#### **South Carolina Donor Designation Rate:**

- 608 lives saved through organ donation from 184 donors.
- 889 individuals received the gift of sight.
- 359 tissue donors' lives enhanced through tissue donation.

#### **South Carolina Donor Registrations:**

- On December 31, 2019, there were 2,280,524 registered donors in South Carolina since the inception of the registry in 2008.
- In 2019, there were a total of 147,190 new donor registrations.
- 97.5% of total new registrations were through the SCDMV.
